- Improve Maths, English and IT

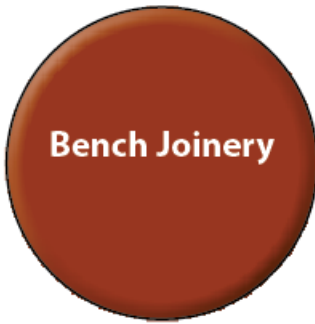
