

ILM Certificate in...

Exploring Enterprise

This course aims to give learners a raised awareness of enterprise. Participants will have the opportunity to explore the purpose, function and operation of enterprises of different types. This will help them to recognise the basic personal knowledge and skills required to work effectively and succeed in the world of work. It is intended to help people explore and make appropriate choices for their own involvement in enterprise. This could be as an employer or employee. The qualification consists of around 34 hours of guided learning.

Level 2

The group will study the following modules:

N1: Enterprise Awareness

- Finance and the Enterprise
- Resources within Enterprise
- Customer Focus
- Communication and Information in Enterprise

N2: Enterprise and the Individual

- Responsibilities and Rights
- Problem Solving Skills
- Coping Skills
- Inter Personal Skills/ Trust
- Options Within Enterprise
