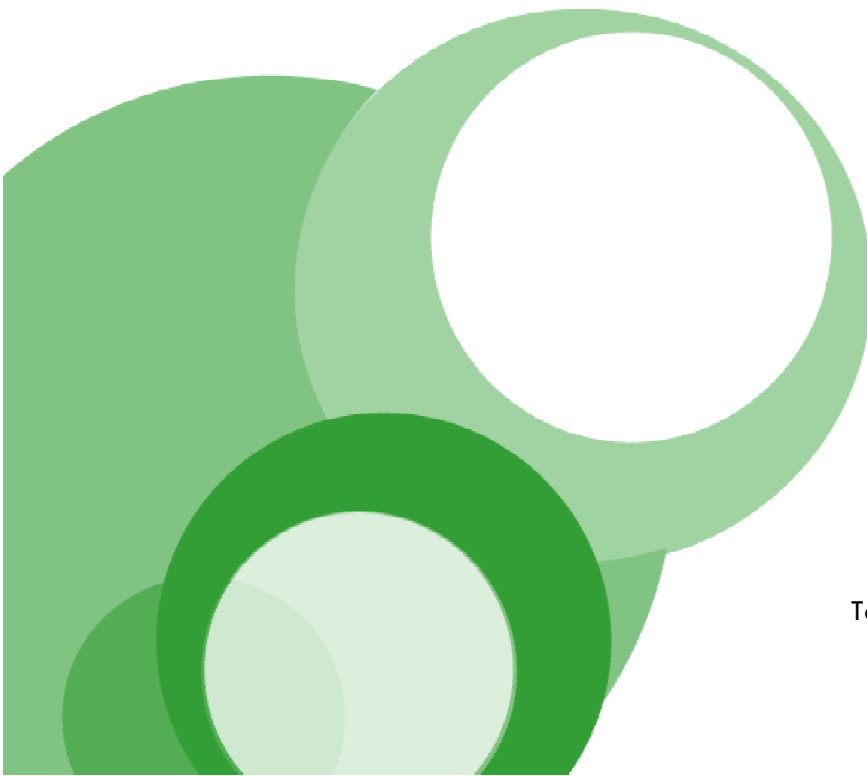

We are happy to do this, but our costs must reflect staff travel time and expenses, preparation and marking, plus IV, registration and certification. Two 1.5 hour sessions are more expensive than a single 3 hour session due to travel time and costs.
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
